The wine has an intense flavour of cherries, raspberries and even chocolate! Followed by a spicy well-balanced harmonious and complex finish.

<b>18 Crozes- Hermitage 2003 France</b>			£23.50
Jammy, rich red fruits with a hint of liquorice and spice			
<b>19 Chateauneuf du Pape Domaine Roger Perrin Rhône, France</b>			£28.50
Full of spice & pepper, displaying the power & exuberant rich fruit typical of this Rhône village. Dry, with plenty of flavours & a perfect finish. From a producer famous for making top quality wine albeit in small quantities.			
<b>20 Chateau Clerc-Milon 5ème Cru Classe Pauillac 1998</b>			£35.50
In 1970 Baron Philippe de Rothschild bought this medium sized estate, tucked between Mouton & Lafitte & said to have first-rate soils. After much replanting, mostly with Cabernet Sauvignon, the hunch seems to have been proved correct, as Clerc-Milon is now an outstanding Pauillac. Impressively structured & with elegance and complexity the wines can be drunk relatively young, although they do have the ability to age well.
